## **JOB SUMMARY**

SAINT is part of the Church of England. We are on a mission to see thousands of people of all ages connect with Jesus in the years ahead and build a meaningful and hope-filled expression of the local church that will serve the community in a healthy way.

We are recruiting a Worship Pastor who is passionate about worship and creating environments where people encounter Jesus. You will be a gifted musician and leader, proficient in one or more musical instruments including acoustic guitar, piano, and vocals, and committed to working as part of a team to lead worship across St Barnabas Homerton and the wider SAINT team.

## **KEY RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- Lead worship at two services per week (Sunday and midweek).
- Collaboration with SAINT Worship Pastor and Homerton location lead to ensure worship culture within the location is healthy and thriving towards the SAINT Worship Department values, preparing worship sets and ensuring a meaningful worship experience.
- Leading worship regularly at our Homerton location, and at other SAINT locations to support the wider SAINT Worship pastors when needed.
- Maintain and develop our PA, instruments, projection, lighting and video equipment in partnership with the Production Team and Location Lead.

## **TEAM DEVELOPMENT**

- Responsible for the recruiting, auditioning, and pastoral care of the Homerton worship crew.
- Particular emphasis on growing and raising up of leaders within the Homerton location worship crew
- Responsible for the deployment, discipleship and rotation of the worship volunteers within Homerton for Sundays and other regular weekly worship services (eg. Alpha)

- Participate in Midweek gatherings.
